Qualifications to Apply	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The applicant must be the undergraduate or graduate student who are enrolled in a university with a student exchange agreement with Mie University.</li> <li>• The applicant must have the purpose of auditing specific subjects.</li> <li>• The applicant must have basic knowledge of either or both Japanese and English. (The lectures are usually given in Japanese, and some of them are in English. To understand the lectures, applicants are required to have enough knowledge of Japanese. If the applicants are unable to understand Japanese, the lectures they can take will be limited.)</li> </ul>
Number of Exchange	<p>It depends on the MOU, however primarily the maximum number of semesters per academic year is 10.</p> <p>Each partner university can send up to 3 candidates who will study for two semesters (1 year) or 6 candidates who will study for one semester (half a year) to the same faculty in an academic year.</p>

Scholarship	<p><b>Mie University International Scholarship</b></p> <p><u>Eligible students:</u> International students who will study at Mie University for one semester or two under the exchange student program.</p> <p><u>The amount of a scholarship:</u> 20,000 yen per month which will be provided for a maximum period of one year.</p> <p>*Only one person from each university can be nominated for this scholarship. The person in charge of the exchange program at each university is responsible for nominating one of their students. Please note that the applicants will be screened and not all the applicants will be adopted.</p> <p>*For details of procedures etc., please check P.13 of the application guideline.</p> <p><b><i>*This scholarship alone is <span style="color: red;">not</span> sufficient to cover all living expenses during your study abroad.</i></b></p>

<p>Health Insurance</p> <p>(English) <a href="#">Insurance</a></p> <p>(Japanese) <a href="#">保険について</a></p>	<p><b><u>National Health Insurance</u></b> (mandatory)</p> <p>Monthly amount: approx. 2,000 yen</p> <p>Once you are insured by the National Health Insurance, you will be responsible for 30% of your personal medical expenses; enrollment is mandatory for international students staying in Japan for more than three months.</p> <p><b><u>Damage &amp; accident insurance for students</u></b> (mandatory)</p> <p>Annual Amount: 1,000 ~ 1,020 yen</p> <p>This insurance covers unexpected accidents that might happen during lectures, experiments, some university activities, and even on the way to or from the university. How much payment you can receive depends on how great the damage or injury is.</p> <p><b><u>Liability insurance for students</u></b> (mandatory)</p> <p>Annual Amount: 340yen ~ 500yen</p> <p>This provides insurance coverage for legal damages due to injuries to others or damage to someone else's property during classes, some university activities, or volunteering.</p> <p><b><u>Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with "Gakkensai" for International Students</u></b></p> <p>This insurance covers all aspects of student life, including injuries, illnesses, and liability accidents 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, including personal life.
